Bio: Dr. Dave Icové is an internationally recognized expert on fire and arson investigation. Recruited by the FBI in 1983 to become one of their first criminal profilers at the Behavioral Science Unit in Quantico, Virginia, Dr. Icové developed the present-day motive classification system for arsonists. He has a PhD in Engineering, is the co-author of several textbooks including Kirk's Fire Investigation, Forensic Fire Scene Reconstruction, and Combating Arson-for-Profit. He has testified as an expert witness in federal and state courts, including three times before U.S.

Congressional Committees regarding arson legislation.

Retiring in 2005 as a Federal Law Enforcement Agent from the U.S. Tennessee Valley Authority Police, Dr. Icove is now a Professor in the College of Engineering at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville; and a Reserve Deputy in the Fire Investigations Unit of the Knox County Sheriff's Office. He is a licensed Professional Engineer, a Certified Fire Investigator (IAAI), a Certified Fire and Explosion Investigator (NAFI), Fellow in the Society of Fire Protection Engineers (SFPE), and a Board-Certified Diplomate in the National Academy of Forensic Engineers (NAFE).
